## Exception Plan for shooting Rimfire Rifles at 200 yards

Current Kenmore Range policy does not allow rimfire rifles to be shot past 100 yards. At the March 2022 Kenmore Range Board meeting, an exception was approved for hosting a 100 / 200 yard Benchrest match for 22LR rimfire rifles on Range 1. Approval was granted based upon the Match having a plan that addresses concerns of both potential safety and potential damage to the range baffles.

The following plan for the 100 / 200 yard 22LR Rimfire Benchrest Match was developed and approved by the Rifle Committee Chair (Martin Morehouse) to address the Kenmore Range Board concerns:

- 1. Competitors must first demonstrate the ability to be "on paper" and **demonstrate proficiency at 100 yards**.
- 2. Competitors must have the **necessary dial up for a 200 yard target** (18 MOA or 5 MILS from 100 yards), before shooting at 200 yards.
- 3. The bottom of the 200 yard Match and sighter targets must be hung within 4 inches of the ground.
- 4. The Match will be shot from the Range 1 benches and Competitors must have a **scope that has 24X or higher magnification**.
- 5. The Match Director will have responsibility for the safe operation of the match and will be responsible for overseeing the above requirements are meet.

Shooting of rimfire rifles on Range 1 past 100 yards is **NOT allowed** unless it is a part of **an approved Match or Event**. Therefore, **NO practicing** with a rimfire rifle is allowed past 100 yards.

100/200 yard 22LR Rimfire Benchrest match dates are provided on the Range Calendar.
